

The Plaintiffs Claims are:

1. The Plaintiffs claim a sum of Indian Rupees 7,182,766.90 as arrears of wages upto 31st January, 2020.
2. The Plaintiffs claim continuing wages as per their Contract of Employment rate from 01st February 2020 till their claims are finally fully settled.
3. The Plaintiffs claim a sum of Indian Rupees 3,446,592.80 (02 months wages) as compensation for hardship experienced due to the failure on the part of the Owners to pay monthly wages promptly and failure to make proper supply of provisions, toiletries, fresh water, diesel oil & lub oil etc.
4. The Plaintiffs claim costs of Repatriation for each Plaintiff to his respective home port.
5. The Plaintiffs claim costs of sign off, costs of hotel accommodation (wherever applicable) and transport to the Airport expenses etc.
6. The Plaintiffs claims interest at 18% per annum from 01st February 2020 till their claims are finally fully settled.
7. The Plaintiffs claim costs of this action & further relief as may be found due to the Plaintiffs.
